

UROFLOW AND BLADDER ULTRASOUND

Important- Please Read Completely

What is it?

The flow study will show the force with which you urinate. The ultrasound will measure the amount of urine left in your bladder after urination.

What will happen?

When you arrive for your appointment you will be asked to urinate into a container in privacy. You will then go into another room for the ultrasound.

How long will it take?

The entire procedure takes approximately 15 to 20 minutes.

How do I prepare for this test?

You will need to drink 16 to 18 ounces of water, two hours prior to your appointment time. It is extremely important that you arrive to your appointment with a full bladder and a strong desire to urinate. It takes your kidneys a couple of hours to process what you drink. If your bladder is not full, you will be asked to reschedule your appointment.

DO NOT URINATE UNTIL THE NURSE BRINGS YOU BACK TO BEGIN THE TEST!
